

## **[D3h] Navigating to ePlans for Pre-2011 Applications**

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For many years, all applications were posted on an online platform called “ePlans.” This platform was not well-liked by staff, applicants nor citizens. As of December 2020, the city implemented a new platform for filing and processing applications called “CityView.”

“Find information about a Specific Application” [Link]

This takes you to a new interactive mapping tool called “Community Development Data Explorer. It allows the user to look up applications in CityView or in ePlans for the last ten years. If you need to see an old application, you can use a different interactive mapping tool called B.O.O.M. Here is the path to the “Interactive Mapping Gallery where B.O.O.M. can be found:

Step #1 – The gallery can be found:

Step #2 - Scroll down and click on “B.O.O.M. - Public viewer

Step #3 - Click on the box accepting the disclaimer agreement

Step #4 - Click on “layers in the bottom left-hand corner

Step #5 - Click on the box next to “Neighborhood Associations”

Step #6 - Click on the + next to “permits and Land Use”

Step #7 - Check the box next to the “planning applications”

Step #8 - Zoom into your NA boundary until blue triangles are visible

Step #9 - Right click on the blue triangle

Step #10 - Click “find data on the map”

Step #11 - The application(s) for that property will be listed in “identify results” panel

Step #12 “ePlans Public” to view the application is ePlans
